NW Fruit — Apple & Pear Sample the Harvest Day, October 10, 2026

What to bring — each sample needs 3 things:

1. This completed form (write clearly)
2. Six unwiped RIPE apples with stems — pick examples of normal color and shape. No plastic bags for apples (it makes them rot) — please use paper to wrap and hold the apples.
3. A 12" stem with leaves in a ziplock bag. Don't use bread bags, saran wrap, or paper bags — they dry the leaves out in one day. Please use a ziplock bag.

Please refrigerate samples until the event.
